



# Important Bird Areas in the AMAZON BASIN

The network of Amazonian Important Bird Areas (IBAs) previewed in this publication provides a simple but effective blueprint for conserving the region's unique biodiversity. Integration of this portfolio of key sites within national and regional development agendas is a first step to ensuring the future of the Amazon and all that depend on it.

# 1. Introduction

The Amazon is the ultimate biodiversity rich tropical Wilderness Area, encompassing more than 6.918.202 million km<sup>2</sup> in nine South American countries. It comprises 53% of the remaining global cover of tropical rainforest and accounts for approximately 10% of all net terrestrial primary production. Within its borders flows the largest river system on Earth.

The Amazon is home to more species of plants and animals than any other Wilderness Area (see Table 1), with perhaps 30% of the world's species found there (Mittermeier *et al.* 2002). Recent surveys indicate at least 40,000 species of plants (30,000 considered endemic), 1500 species of birds (263 endemics), 427 mammals (173 endemics), 387 reptiles (216 endemics) and 427 amphibians (364 endemics). The Amazon is also home to a wealth of indigenous cultures with about 350 known tribes. As with the biodiversity they depend on, the future of many of these tribes is threatened (e.g. about one third of the 170 tribes in the Brazilian Amazon have populations of less than 200 people (Mittermeier *et al.* 2002).

Threats to the Amazon are equal to its immense size. In the Brazilian Amazon, deforestation has averaged 18,000 km<sup>2</sup> per year since 1998, and the total area deforested by 2003 was 648,500 km<sup>2</sup> or 16.2% of its original cover (Costa K. *et al.* 2009). This represents the

highest deforestation rate for any tropical forest wilderness area in the world. Logging remains the biggest threat, through clear cutting and selective extraction; the area selectively logged is approximately equal to the deforested area. Major deforestation drivers include agricultural expansion policies, and a number of existing and planned infrastructure development projects.

Although the Amazon benefits from a number of conservation initiatives, no single reserve is currently protected to the extent required, and over the entire basin, just 8.3% of the area receives some form of protection (Mittermeier *et al.* 2002). Conservation of the Amazon requires a landscape level approach. Such approaches typically involve the identification and integration into broader socio-political agendas of inter connected networks of core conservation areas, linked by habitat corridors, and protected by buffer zones.

A fundamental challenge is to identify the sites which should form the core conservation areas. One clearly demonstrated and cost effective way to do so is through the identification of Important Bird Areas (IBAs). BirdLife International's IBA Program is designed to identify, protect and manage a network of sites of international importance for birds and biodiversity in general, and to compliment conservation approaches focused on species and habitats.

## **2. Important Bird Areas: Approach and criteria**




IBAs are key sites for the conservation of birds and other biodiversity, and comprise building blocks for conservation planning. They are identified nationally, by applying internationally agreed criteria, and using data gathered locally. The worldwide network of IBAs forms an essential foundation for global nature conservation.

To qualify as an IBA, a site must meet one or more of four Global IBA criteria that address the two primary issues of concern in site conservation: vulnerability and irreplaceability (see “Global IBA criteria” box 1).

IBAs are identified through participatory processes that engage local stakeholders (including government agencies, NGOs and local experts) and provide opportunities for all to contribute ideas, information and to learn about the process. By such means, IBA identification provides a mechanism to build solid foundations for effective conservation of IBAs through helping to develop technical and conservation capacity, build partnerships between key organizations (both government and non-government) generate broad ownership of the initial site inventory, and focus new survey work on the most important knowledge gaps.

# 3. Identifying IBAs in the Amazon

## 3.1. Definition of the Amazon

For the purposes of this analysis, the limits of the Amazon basin were defined following the proposal of OTCA (Organization of the Amazon Cooperation Treaty) and the European Comission in 2005:

"The Amazon Basin is defined as the catchment area conformed by the fluvial network of the Amazon and Tocantins river basins, extending through Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru and Venezuela, from tributaries to the estuary of the Amazon River (including salt water ecosystems). This includes Amazonia sensu stricto, the

area regarding land tenure (compounded by the fact that in many areas formal land management structures do not exist). These present significant challenges for the identification of IBAs. They were in part resolved through combining species data with maps of soil types, topography, forest types, and logging concessions. In addition, socio-economic data were used to guide the delineation process, to avoid areas that are already heavily utilized or socio-politically complex, and to incorporate existing protected areas into the IBA network. Importantly, it was recognized that there is no theoretical maximum size for an IBA: what is sensible from a biological perspective must be balanced with what is practical for conservation.

area of the Amazon and Tocantins river basins, dominated by the Amazonian Low Forest Biome (it also includes smaller areas of other types of forest and non forest vegetation with its associated fauna); as well as the eastern slopes of the Andes from Bolivia in the south to Colombia in the north" (Eva & Huber. 2005), an altitudinal limit of 700 m was also established.

## 3.2. IBA identification in the Amazon Basin

The Amazon basin, as with other Wilderness Areas, is characterized by large expanses of relatively homogeneous habitat, a scarcity of biodiversity distribution data (which when available is often biased towards access routes such as roads and rivers), and a lack of informa-

This has resulted in the identification of a number of very large IBAs, an approach which is consistent with existing Amazonian protected areas. In many cases, where a site has already been designated as an actual or proposed protected area, the existing boundaries were accepted as the boundaries of the IBA. Only in exceptional circumstances were they modified, for example if they excluded an area of particular importance.

The IBAs of the five countries of the Tropical Andes (Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru and Venezuela) were first identified in 2004. During 2008, information for those IBAs lying within the Amazon basin was updated, through nationally-led processes. The IBAs of Amazonian Brazil, Guyana, Suriname and French Guiana were identified for the first time during 2007-2008 through participatory national processes.

To date, 130 IBAs have been identified in the Amazon Region (Figure 1) covering a total area of 120,679,121 ha (17.24% of the total area); 7 in Ecuador, 10 in Colombia, 13 in Peru, 14 in Bolivia, 18 in Venezuela, 42 in Brazil, 9 in Suriname, 8 in Guyana and 9 in French Guiana. Of these IBAs, 96 have been confirmed under the globally



### Global IBA Criteria:

Box 1

- **Species of global conservation concern (CR, EN, VU and NT species on the IUCN Red List)**

The site regularly holds significant numbers of one or more globally threatened species or Near Threatened species (NT).

- **Assemblage of restricted-range species (species restricted to EBAs with ranges of  $\leq 50,000 \text{ km}^2$ )**

The site is known or thought to hold a significant component of the restricted-range species whose breeding distributions define an Endemic Bird Area.

- **Assemblage of biome-restricted species**

The site is known or thought to hold a significant component of the group of species whose distributions are largely or wholly confined to one biome.

- **Congregations**

The site is known or thought to hold, on a regular basis, a globally significant concentration of one or more congregatory species.

threatened species criterion for a total of 101 threatened and Near Threatened species, 85 under the restricted-range species criterion, 65 under the biome-restricted criterion and 14 under the congregatory species criterion.

While great advances have been made in identifying IBAs in the Amazon basin, it is important to bear in mind that the current network of sites reflects our state of knowledge and says nothing regarding the conservation importance of surrounding areas not identified as IBAs. These should be considered, at a minimum, as priority areas for research, and potentially as priority areas for conservation through a broad landscape-scale approach.

### 3.3. Threats to Amazonian IBAs

During 2008, Colombia, Ecuador, Venezuela, Peru and Bolivia implemented a series of workshops to update

threats to Amazon IBAs in each country.

A total of 62 IBAs were evaluated by people living and/or working in the field. Except for Brazil, these countries also carried out an internal analysis to identify threats in Amazonian IBAs. As a result of these two processes a total of 104 IBAs (out of 132) were evaluated.

Increasing environmental degradation is altering ecosystem services in the Amazon. The most frequent direct threats affecting Amazonian IBAs are: agricultural expansion and intensification; over exploitation, persecution and control of species; and energy production and mining (Figure 2).

In general terms, change in land use in the Amazon is the result of rapid and disorderly colonization over time, which has changed Amazonian vegetation cover. Factors underlying land use change include the dynamics of regional productivity, such as agricultural expansion

(mainly driven by monocultures) and cattle raising, informal mining, illegal logging, the development of large infrastructure projects such as those within IIRSA, market forces; changes in attitudes within the population, among others. Different factors have different effects and relative importances in each country.


Deforestation continues to be driven by the same factors as in the 1990s, though since 2000 annual forest clearing has shown an increasingly tight correlation to commodity prices, especially soy and beef, which have benefited from the near eradication of foot-and-mouth disease in cattle and agricultural innovation that has converted the region's poor acidic soils into land suitable for extensive soy farms. As more Amazon land has come under agricultural cultivation, rising prices for commodities have served as an impetus for forest clearing.

Soybean cultivation in the Amazon has expanded rapidly in recent years due to improved infrastructure in the region and rising demand for vegetable oils for food, industrial uses, and biodiesel production. Since 1990 the area of land planted with soybeans in Amazonian states has expanded at the rate of 14.1% per year (16.8% annually since 2000) and now covers more than eight million hectares. While the Amazon's largest soy crushers have had a ban on soy produced from newly deforested lands since July 2006, soy is nonetheless seen as an important indirect driver of deforestation in the Brazilian Amazon by driving up land prices and creating an impetus for infrastructure improvements that promote forest clearing. In areas where soils and topography are suitable for mechanized soy cultivation, rainforest lands are typically cleared for low intensity cattle ranching then sold to soy producers some two to three years later. Ranchers then move into frontier areas, spurring deforestation (Butler. 2008).

On a historical basis the Amazon has proved to be resilient to climate change, large scale human disturbance by pre Colombian populations, and even periods of fire and extreme drought during millennial *El Niño* events (Butler. 2008). Nevertheless, the present onslaught of forces affecting the Amazon is unprecedented. Never before has the region experienced the simultaneous impact of large scale forest loss and degradation, fragmentation, forest fires, and climate change.

Scientists are working to understand the potential impact of climate change on Earth's largest rainforest. Some models suggest parts of the Amazon will experience elevated temperatures and less rainfall, while other regions will get more rain, but the debate is far from settled when it comes to predicting the sensitivity and responsiveness of the region's ecosystems to elevated CO<sub>2</sub> levels.

# Bolivia

The Bolivian Amazon covers an area of approximately 326,400 km<sup>2</sup> in the east of the country, representing approximately 30% of the country's area. Bolivia's Amazon region is a complex mosaic of different humid forest and savanna formations.

Changes in land use pose the biggest threat to the region's biodiversity, primarily through the clearance of large tracts of forest for agriculture and human settlements. However, logging for timber and burning are also significant threats, with notable impacts on localized climates and habitat types, leading to an overall decrease in species richness.

A total of 14 IBAs have been identified in the Bolivian Amazon, covering an area of approximately 77,732 km<sup>2</sup> (or 34% of the total Bolivian IBA network). The majority of ecosystems and habitat types present in the region are represented within these IBAs.


This network of key sites holds populations of 29 bird species of conservation concern (13 globally threatened and 14 Near Threatened), three restricted range species, and 83 species which are characteristic of Amazonian biomes. Eleven Amazonian species of conservation concern only trigger IBA criteria in Bolivia, of note are the Critically Endangered and endemic Blue throated Macaw (*Ara glaucogularis*), present at three sites in the Llanos de Moxos and the Endangered White winged Nightjar (*Eleothreptus candicans*) at Estación Biológica del Beni (BO038).

# Brazil

The majority of the Amazon basin lies within Brazil (some 2 million km<sup>2</sup>) covering seven of the 26 Brazilian states. Although it covers over a third (39%) of the country, it has less than 15 million inhabitants (of the total Brazilian population of 165 million).

The main threat to the Brazilian Amazon is deforestation driven by the expansion of the agricultural frontier, particularly in creating areas for livestock or pastures. The annual rate of deforestation increased consistently from 1990 to 2003 due to a mix of local, national, and international factors. Seventy percent of all formerly forested land in the Amazon, and 91% of land deforested since 1970 are used for livestock pasture. Furthermore, Brazil is currently the second largest global producer of soybeans (af-

ter the United States), mostly for livestock feed. As prices for soybeans rise, the soy farmers are pushing northwards into forested areas of the Amazon. Also, sugar cane expansion for ethanol production may replace soybean production in south and central Brazil, pushing the soybean expansion to the Amazon.

In Brazil, 42 IBAs have been identified in the Amazon, 27 sites under the A1 criterion, including **CR**, **EN**, **VU** and **NT** species (21 globally threatened species and 23 near threatened species); 21 sites for assemblages of restricted range species (criterion A2); one under A3, for biome restricted species (this criterion has not yet been applied in Brazil), and four for congregatory species (A4 criteria).

# Colombia

The Colombian Amazon is located in the South of the country, covering six provinces as well as the Serranía de la Macarena in Meta. The region covers an area of 419,346 km<sup>2</sup>, representing 36% of the country's area and 5.5% of the total Amazon basin.

A total of 988 bird species have been recorded from the Colombian Amazon, more than 75% of the total number of species reported for the entire Amazon basin (Mejia et al. 2007).

A total of 69 trigger species are represented in the 10 IBAs identified in the Colombian Amazon, of which 13 are of global conservation concern, three of them Globally Threatened and 10 of them Near Threatened. One such species is Wattled Curassow or pyuria (*Crax globulosa*) which is suffering a rapid population decline due to hunting and habitat loss. This Vulnerable species is found in the IBAs Isla Mirití and Isla Mocagua y Zaragocilla, representing two of the best opportunities to conserve the species regionally, thanks to intact habitats, healthy populations and good local awareness through community work undertaken by various organizations.


The Colombian Amazon is also critical to the conservation of restricted range birds and in particular those of two Endemic Bird Areas: Orinoco Negro White sand forest (EBA 065) and the Upper Amazon Napo lowlands (EBA 66). Two secondary areas of endemism are also of note: the Sierra de Chiribiquete and Macarena Mountains.

# Ecuador

The Ecuadorian Amazon covers 131,000 km<sup>2</sup>, 45% of the country's area but just 1.7% of the overall Amazon basin, made up of the upper basins of the Napo, Tigre and Pastaza rivers.

The greatest threat faced by the region is deforestation driven by the expansion of the agricultural frontier, a process which started in the 1970s, and is now believed to clear 1000 to 3000 km<sup>2</sup> annually. Additionally, activities such as exploration for oil and logging have increased in the last 20 years.

Seven IBAs have been identified in the Ecuadorian Amazon, covering 39,096 km<sup>2</sup> and representing

most of the ecosystems within the region. Although these IBAs only correspond to 7% of the country's total number of sites, they represent almost 43% of the total IBA area, and covering almost a third of the country's Amazon region. Together, they maintain populations of 16 bird species of conservation concern, four of them globally threatened and 12 Near Threatened. The Near Threatened species include the endemic Cocha Antshrike (*Thamnophilus praecox*) and the near endemic Foothill Elenia (*Myiopagis olallai*), both triggering IBA criteria at just two sites. Seven sites have also been identified for the presence of restricted range species and five sites for biome restricted species.

# French Guiana


The Amazon forests of French Guiana cover more than 8 million ha, representing 92% of this French overseas département. Nearly 90% of this area is still intact, making it one of the largest tracts of pristine rainforest in the world. Tropical rainforest and associated ecosystems include terra firme forests, plains, rivers, cambrouses or dense grass ecosystems and inselbergs.

Although large scale deforestation has not taken place in French Guiana (due to the inaccessibility of much of its area), logging and gold mining have seriously degraded forests in some areas.

Apart from three coastal sites, the remaining nine IBAs lie within French Guiana's Amazon region, covering an area of approximately 4 million ha. Several ecosystems and habitat types present in the region are represented within these IBAs.

There are only three species of global conservation concern covered by the IBA network, all of them Near Threatened. These are Blue cheeked Amazon (*Amazona dufresniana*), Harpy Eagle (*Harpia harpyja*) and Crested Eagle (*Morphnus guianensis*). Also, six sites have been identified for biome restricted species, under criterion A3, including the Parc Amazonien de Guyane & Saül IBA (GF011), holding 43 of the 45 ANT biome restricted species in French Guiana.

# Guyana

Of Guyana's total area of 215,000 km<sup>2</sup>, over 75% (or 16.1 million ha) is covered by Amazonian forests making it one of the countries with most intact forest in the region. Guyana is also the largest of the three Guianas, with the biggest population and highest population density.

Since colonial times, the main cause of forest loss in Guyana has been the creation and expansion of coffee and cotton plantations, and later, sugar. More recently, Guyanese forests are facing other threats such as mining and logging.

A total of ten IBAs have been identified in Guyana, of which eight are within the Guyanese Amazon, covering an area of at least 350,000 ha. However, three sites are yet to be delimited and are not included in this estimate. Furthermore, as the Guyanese IBA process is still ongoing, it is expected that more sites will be added shortly.

A total of 265 species have been recorded at this network of key sites to date, of which three are globally threatened and trigger IBA criteria. A further four Near Threatened species trigger IBA criteria at five sites. Two IBAs have been identified for restricted range species, but the A3 criterion is yet to be applied.


# Peru

The Peruvian Amazon is one of the most biodiverse regions within the Amazon Basin, in part a result of the extensive transition area between Amazonian and Andean forests. The entire area is very humid, with annual precipitation of 2000 mm or above (and locally reaching 5000 mm at the base of the Andes). The 500,000 km<sup>2</sup> of the Peruvian Amazon (almost 40% of the country's total area) is divided into a complex mosaic of indigenous lands, forest concessions and private properties.

A network of 14 IBAs (12% of the total number in the country) has been identified in the Peruvian Amazon, covering 138,798 km<sup>2</sup>. The principal threat to these sites is habitat loss due to agricultural expansion, driven by the migration of people from the Andes. However, mining and oil extraction are also major threats. These 14 key sites hold populations of over 57 species of global conservation concern, 6 Endangered, 18 Vulnerable and 30 Near Threatened. Of these, 14 are endemic to Peru, including the Endangered Yellow browed Toucanet (*Aulacorhynchus huallagae*), Golden backed Mountain tanager (*Buthraupis aureodorsalis*) and Plain tailed Warbling finch (*Poospiza altilcola*). Thirteen sites have also been identified for the presence of restricted range species and nine for the presence of biome restricted species.

# Suriname

Suriname forms part of the Guianan Shield in the northeast of the Amazon basin. The Amazon region covers 142,800 km<sup>2</sup>, representing over 80% of the country. This region is mainly covered by tropical forest, although important savanna habitats are also found inland, as well as slightly higher altitude "mountain" or "moss" forests. Much of this area remains to be explored ornithologically, but, to date 727 species have been recorded in the Amazon Region.

Although most of the forests in Suriname are undisturbed due to the low human population density, the main threat facing the Amazon region in this country is deforestation caused by gold mining and timber exploitation. Bauxite mining is also responsible for the

destruction of large tracts of forest.

Nine IBAs have been identified within the Surinamese Amazon, covering an area of 43,090 km<sup>2</sup> and with good representation of Amazon ecosystems. Six species of conservation concern trigger IBA criteria over this network of sites, five of which are Near Threatened and Sun Parakeet (*Aratinga Solstitialis*) is Endangered. Sipaliwini Natuurreservaat (SR013) in Suriname is only one of two sites where this species triggers IBA criteria. Three sites have been identified for the presence of restricted range species and nine for the presence of biome restricted species.

# Venezuela

The Venezuelan Amazon covers an area of 230,000 km<sup>2</sup> in the states of Amazonas and Bolívar, representing 36% of the country's terrestrial area, and 2.5% of the total Amazon basin. Nineteen indigenous groups live in the Venezuelan Amazon, including the Hiwi, Wotuhjeje, Puinave, Piakoko, Baniba, Warekena, Kuripako, Yeral, Bare, Yanomami, Sanem, Ninam, Pemón and Kapon.

Expansion of the agricultural frontier represents the biggest threat to the Venezuelan Amazon. However, almost all of the Amazonian IBAs are fully protected under national protection categories.

A quarter of Venezuela's IBAs lie within the Amazon

region (18 sites), covering an area of 151,419 km<sup>2</sup>, representing over 70% of the total IBA area in the country. The majority of the region's ecosystems are covered by Amazonian IBAs. This network of key sites holds populations of nine bird species of conservation concern, two of them globally threatened and seven Near Threatened species. Endemic species triggering IBA criteria in the Amazon region include the Critically Endangered Carrizal Seedeater (*Amaurospiza carriola*), the Vulnerable Orinoco Softtail (*Thripophaga cherriei*) and the Near Threatened Saffron breasted Redstart (*Myioborus cardonai*) and Duida Grass-finches (*Emberizoides duidae*). Fifteen sites were identified for restricted range species and 16 for biome restricted species.

# 5. Setting priorities

By definition, all IBAs are priorities for conservation. However, it is clear that action is needed more urgently for some than for others. Since the resources to take action are always limited, it is essential to work out where interventions should be targeted first. This does not imply that any IBAs are dispensable, but provides a rational way of minimising biodiversity loss.

Setting priorities for action is not straightforward. Many interacting factors are involved, and how

in turn for each IBA category (threatened species, restricted-range species, biome-restricted species and congregations) based on the species populations it holds. These scores were then combined to give a single, overall importance ranking. This allows the different 'currencies' of the IBA categories to be combined into one measure. The scoring assumes that more trigger species (species which "trigger" the application of the IBA criteria), higher species threat status and/or larger congregations equate to greater importance.

these are balanced is often a matter of values as much as of objective science. A priority setting exercise may have no 'right' answers, but one way to think about how to set priorities is to consider the potential impact on biodiversity if no effective intervention is made at a site. Simply put, this depends on the relative biodiversity importance of a site and the degree of threat, or vulnerability. Where a site has high importance and high threat, it represents a potential large loss of biodiversity in the near future. Intervention at such a site is more urgent than at a site with lower importance and/or lower threat.

For IBAs in the Amazon basin, priorities have been set by combining a measure of threat with a measure of biological importance. As these are priorities for action, the urgency and scale of action are primarily determined by threat.

## 5.1. Biological importance

The biological importance of each IBA was assessed in terms of the IBA criteria met. Each IBA was ranked

## 5.2. Assessing threats

Threats to IBAs were assessed using a standardized threat classification (IUCN 2006) scoring with regard to their likely impacts on the bird species of concern, looking at timing (occurrence), scope (geographic extent) and severity. The single highest score from among all the different threats assessed at a site was taken to be the overall threat score for that IBA.

Each national partner organization held a series of workshops with local people and/or researchers from NGOs and government to obtain first hand information about the threats at IBAs. The threat and importance scores were then combined allowing IBAs to be categorized by priority for action (urgent, high and critical).

## 5.3. National priority IBAs

The national priority setting processes have identified a total of 8 IBAs as Critical for action, 33 IBAs as Urgent priorities for action, and 54 IBAs as High priorities for action (see Table 1).

## 5.4. Assessing threats at the regional level

Threats across the Amazon basin were assessed through a multi-temporal analysis of satellite imagery covering the period 2000-2009, using products from the Brazilian PRODES project as a baseline (<http://www.obt.inpe.br/prodes>). The analysis was conducted by Guyra Paraguay's remote sensing laboratory, and covered a total area of 6,918,203 km<sup>2</sup> (southeastern Brazil and parts of Colombia, the Guianas and Venezuela were excluded due to a lack of cloud-free imagery).

During the study period there was a marked increase in the area cleared for agriculture, from 543,121 km<sup>2</sup> (7.9% of the study area) in 2000 to 697,636 km<sup>2</sup> (10% of the area) in 2009 (Fig. 11).

An assessment of the principal land cover changes between 2000 and 2009 identified 20 deforestation

arrow indicates the approximate direction of the deforestation, the width its magnitude, and the length its geographic extent.

Land use change was assessed within 43 IBAs, primarily within Brazil. Among those IBAs most affected by deforestation during the period were Baixada Maranhense (BR032) with 783,239 ha deforested (38.5% of its area), Reentrâncias Maranhenses/Paraenses (BR030) with 330,073 ha cleared (29% of its area), Gurupi (BR031) with 231,779 ha cleared (16.6% of its area) and Río Capim (BR013) with 245,399 ha cleared (11.4% of its area).

The deforestation maps were used to identify fourteen subregions within the Amazon basin ranked in terms of the actual and expected future degree of threats to the IBAs. The four most threatened subregions were all found to lie in the southern Amazon, with the next two along the lower reaches of the Amazon River (Fig. 13).





**Figure 14.** Subregions of the Amazon ranked by threat level




Figure 15. Reentrâncias Maranhenses/Paraenses (BR030)




Figure 16. Gurupi (BR031)





Figure 17. Río Capim (BR 013)



## 5.5. Regional priority IBAs

Within each subregion of the Amazon, information on the threat level of each IBA (derived from the deforestation maps) was crossed with information on biological importance (gathered through national participatory processes) to identify the highest priority IBAs for conservation action within the Amazon basin.

## 5.6. Amazon IBAs and IIRSA

The Initiative for the Integration of Regional Infrastructure in South America (IIRSA) was established at the First Meeting of South American Presidents in Brasilia in 2000. The initiative aims to develop transport, energy and telecommunications infrastructure in order to achieve greater integration between the 12 South American countries.

IIRSA's objectives are to:

- Develop and modernize transport, energy and telecommunications infrastructure in an integral manner in South America.
- Improve competitiveness of South American economies as well as their insertion into international markets.
- Promote fair and sustainable economic and social development in South American countries.

IIRSA is implemented through 10 regions for integration and development. Four of these regions fall within the Amazon basin:

- Andean region (Bolivia-Colombia-Ecuador-Peru-Venezuela)
- Amazon region (Brazil-Colombia-Ecuador-Peru)
- Guianas region (Brazil-Guyana-Suriname-Venezuela)
- Peru-Brazil-Bolivia region


Within each region, transport and/or communications infrastructure will be built, linking countries and industries and representing a total investment of approximately US \$69 billion. Already, many projects have been completed or are underway, often financed through novel schemes, whereby construction is licensed to private firms with national governments acting as guarantors to multilateral banks who finance the projects.

An overlay of Amazon IBAs with planned and existing IIRSA projects as of 2009 suggests that 43 IBAs



will be affected by infrastructure developments: eight in Bolivia, 14 in Brazil, three in Colombia, four in Ecuador, eight in Peru, three in Suriname and three in Venezuela (Fig. 18).

### 5.6.1. Key actions to minimize impacts of infrastructure development in IBAs.

- Adopt IBAs as a tool to guide the assessment of potential impacts and the implementation of donor safeguard policies.
- Use IBAs to ensure increased consistency and transparency of donor safeguard policies, assist with their standardization and compatibility, and generate greater coherence in their application. Ensure compliance with environmental safeguards through the completion of environmental impact assessments and strategic environmental assessments prior to the initiation of project activities.

The social and environmental impacts of these projects are likely to be substantial and it is critical that steps be taken to minimize negative effects and maximize the benefits from these large-scale infrastructure projects.

- Ensure that all viable alternatives to infrastructural projects within IBAs have been evaluated, and that the least environmentally and socially damaging option has been chosen.
- Ensure that all projects which negatively impact IBAs include appropriate and sufficient mitigation measures.
- Develop environmental impact models and provide information on the likely impacts of projects in a format that facilitates decision-making by local and regional governments as well as financing organizations. Information provided by the Corporación Andina de Fomento (CAF).
