

*Alectoris chukar* is resident in south-eastern Europe, which accounts for less than a quarter of its global range. Its European breeding population is large (>660,000 pairs), but underwent a large decline between 1970–1990. Although the species was stable in much of its European range during 1990–2000, it declined substantially in its Turkish stronghold, and probably underwent a large decline (>30%) overall. Consequently, it is provisionally evaluated as Vulnerable.
