Apus unicolor breeds only in Europe, with its entire global breeding range confined to Madeira and the Canary Islands. The current size of the population on Madeira is unknown, but the total breeding population is small (possibly as few as 2,500 pairs), and was probably stable between 1970–1990. Although trend data were not available during 1990–2000, there was no evidence to suggest that the species declined. Nevertheless, its population size renders it susceptible to the risks affecting small populations, and consequently it is provisionally evaluated as Rare.
