Grus virgo is a summer visitor to Turkey, Ukraine and southern Russia, with Europe accounting for less than half of its global breeding range. Its European breeding population is relatively small (<25,000 pairs), but increased between 1970–1990. Although the small population in Turkey declined during 1990–2000, the species was stable in Ukraine and increased in the Russian stronghold, and hence continued to increase overall. Consequently, it is evaluated as Secure.
