Charadrius asiaticus has a predominantly Central Asian breeding distribution, which just extends into Europe in southern Russia. Its European breeding population is very small (as few as 130 pairs), and declined substantially between 1970–1990. Although its trend in Russia during 1990–2000 was not known, there is no evidence to suggest that earlier declines ceased, and the species probably continued to decline. As a consequence of this inferred continuing decline and its small population size, the species is provisionally evaluated as Endangered.
