*Stercorarius pomarinus* breeds in arctic Russia, with Europe accounting for less than a quarter of its global breeding range. Its European breeding population is relatively small (<50,000 pairs), but was broadly stable between 1970–1990. No trend data were available for 1990–2000, but there was no evidence to suggest that the species's status had deteriorated since 1990, and it is provisionally evaluated as Secure.
