Phoenicurus erythrogastrus has a predominantly Asian distribution, which just extends into Europe in the Caucasus. Its European breeding population is small (as few as 2,100 pairs), but its trend between 1970–1990 was unknown. Although the species remains poorly known, with no trend data available for Georgia during 1990–2000, it was stable in Russia and Azerbaijan, and was probably stable overall. Nevertheless, its population size renders it susceptible to the risks affecting small populations, and consequently it is provisionally evaluated as Rare.
