*Locustella lanceolata* has a predominantly Asian distribution, but its breeding range extends just west of the Urals into north-east European Russia. Its European breeding population is relatively small (<100,000 pairs), but was stable between 1970–1990. No trend data were available for the Russian population during 1990–2000, but there was no evidence to suggest that its status deteriorated significantly. Consequently, the species is provisionally evaluated as Secure.
