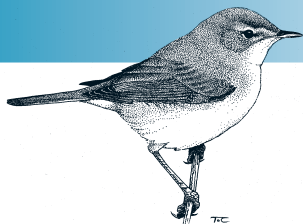

Hippolais caligata is a summer visitor to central and eastern Russia, with Europe accounting for less than a quarter of its global breeding range. Its European breeding population is relatively small (<80,000 pairs), and was stable between 1970–1990. Trend data were not available for the Russian population during 1990–2000 (although the population in Finland increased), but there was no evidence to suggest that its status deteriorated significantly. Consequently, the species is provisionally evaluated as Secure.
