Petronia brachydactyla is a summer visitor to south-eastern Turkey and parts of the Caucasus, with Europe accounting for less than a quarter of its global breeding range. Its European breeding population is small (as few as 7,000 pairs), but was probably broadly stable between 1970–1990, and underwent a large increase overall during 1990–2000. Although the size of the European population could render it susceptible to the risks affecting small populations, it is marginal to a much larger non-European population. Consequently, the species is evaluated as Secure.
