Pyrrhula murina is endemic to Europe, where it has an extremely small range (<50 km²) on the island of São Miguel in the Azores. Its European breeding population is very small (c.240 birds), but its trend between 1970–1990 was unknown. Although the species probably declined during 1990–2000, no quantitative trend data were available for this period. If this trend were confirmed, the species could qualify as Critically Endangered. In the meantime, as a consequence of its very small population, this globally threatened species is provisionally evaluated as Endangered.
