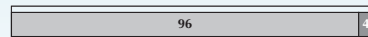


Emberiza buchanani is a summer visitor to Turkey and the Caucasus, with Europe accounting for less than a quarter of its global breeding range. Its European breeding population is small (as few as 6,400 pairs), and its trend between 1970–1990 was unknown. However, the species was probably stable overall during 1990–2000. Although the size of the European population could render it susceptible to the risks affecting small populations, it is marginal to a much larger non-European population. Consequently, it is provisionally evaluated as Secure.
