

Emberiza caesia is a summer visitor to south-east Europe, which constitutes >75% of its global breeding range. Its European breeding population is large (>140,000 pairs), and was stable between 1970–1990. Although the species underwent a small decline in its Turkish stronghold during 1990–2000, its populations in Greece and Cyprus remained stable, and it probably declined only slightly overall. Consequently, it is provisionally evaluated as Secure.
